The Feast of St. Rose

This year our parish feast day falls on Friday, August 23rd. In honor of the feast, you can obtain a plenary indulgence by devoutly visiting the church, reciting the Lord's Prayer and Creed, and praying for the Pope's intentions. The Papal prayer intention for August is for political leaders. To receive the indulgence you need to go to Confession and receive Holy Communion within several days before or after August 23rd. St. Rose was a Third Order Dominican. She was born April 20, 1586 and died August 24, 1617 in Lima, Peru. St. Rose is the first person born in the America's to be canonized. *St. Rose, Pray for us!*

Part II: The OCIA - What is it?

Last week we learned that RCIA is now called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. We also learned that the OCIA is the normal way for unbaptized persons and those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition to become a Catholic through a process. Let's look a little more at the process. For those who have never been Baptized, the OCIA gradually uncovers the story of God's salvation for all humanity; the mystery of Jesus life, death and resurrection; and the workings of the Holy Spirit as revealed in the beliefs, sacramental life and spiritual practices of the Catholic Church. The initiation of catechumens (the unbaptized) is a gradual process that takes place within us, the community of the faithful, and works within the Church's liturgical year. Together with the catechumens, the rest of us reflect upon the value of the paschal mystery, renew our own conversion, and by our example we lead the catechumens to obey the Holy Spirit more generously. For Baptized Christians who seek full communion with the Catholic Church, the OCIA includes rites and pastoral practice similar to that for the catechumens (the unbaptized). However, because they are already baptized, their needs oftentimes differ. For Baptized Catholics who have received no other faith formation and have not received the sacraments of Confirmation and/or Eucharist, the OCIA uses the same process with differing pastoral practices to become a fully initiated Catholic. Frequently the OCIA process is used by fully initiated Catholics (those who have already celebrated Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) to update themselves with current Church teachings by attending the OCIA sessions.
