### 46 Rosarios en Honor a Ntra. Sra. de Guadalupe

El 28 de octubre después de la Misa de las 5:00 p.m. rezaremos el primer rosario del Manto de la Virgen de Guadalupe. La trad

ición consiste en rezar los 46 rosarios, un rosario por cada estrella que lleva el manto de la Virgen de Guadalupe. Se rezara uno por día, empezando el 28 de octubre, terminando el 12 de diciembre. Serán todas las tardes a las 6:30 p.m. con excepción de los miércoles, sábados y domingo, estos días el rosario se hará después de la Misa de la tarde. *Los días 9 de noviembre, 4 y 7 diciembre el rosario se hará en la capilla del convento.*

### 46 Rosaries in Honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe

On October 28<sup>th</sup>, after the 5:00 p.m. Mass, we will pray the first rosary of the Mantle of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The tradition consists of praying 46 rosaries, a rosary for each star that Our Lady of Guadalupe has on her mantel. We will pray one rosary a day, starting on October 28<sup>th</sup> all the way through December 12<sup>th</sup>. They will be every afternoon at 6:30 p.m. with the exception of Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays, these days the rosary will be prayed after the afternoon Mass. *November 9<sup>th</sup>, December 4<sup>th</sup> and December 7<sup>th</sup> the rosary will be held in the convent chapel.*
